The Washington Township Trustees met in regular session with Smith, Powell and Euler present. Chairman Euler presided. Guests in attendance were Craig Spoores and Todd Buehrer. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Roll Call: Powell – yes, Smith - yes Euler – yes. Motion approved. The Audit Committee approved the bank statements and financial reports for April, 2017.

Craig Spoores discussed issues with his neighbor's property. More and more junk cars keep filling up behind his barn. Spoores discussed this with Chad Johnson and he stated he was working on two others he does not have time for that one right now. Powell read an affidavit concerning junk vehicles within the Township; he believes this could be helpful in this matter. Euler asked if there was any letters issued in the past. Smith stated he thought Chad went out and talked to him. Spoores said they moved the vehicles closer to the building after Chad went and talked to them. Smith said there is another pile of cars on Robinson and Tontogany Creek, two cars and a trailer with expired licenses. Powell will look into the affidavit form. Euler asked Spoores on a Variance in Williamsburg. Spoores stated Chad has not received the form back for the variance request as of yet.

Todd told Trustees all 3 road cuts are complete. The one on Range Line Road, there is a tile that someone is complaining about eroding the bank. Todd looked at it but it's an old galvanized tile that is rotting. Smith stated he thinks Gary Vollmar has his field tile tied into this. Todd does not believe the Township has anything tied into this tile. Todd said there is a water leak at the park. They used 37,000 gallons the month of April. Craig suggested getting a hold of Brandon from NWS to listen. A new waterline may have to be put in. Powell stated the park restrooms look better than before. Todd stated he is having trouble finding someone to replace the doors for the restrooms. He will keep looking. Todd believes he should be getting the Durapatcher back next week; they also went out today to fill the holes on Tontogany Creek. Hopefully Friday he will start road mowing, he has two funerals this weekend. Cemeteries are weed whipped. Todd asked Smith if there is something to slow the growth of grass. Smith stated there is a product called Embark. Todd will be meeting with Don to get the electric to the Cemetery.

Euler asked Todd if we were getting Gerken to fill in the crossovers. Todd stated he will probably Durapatch them but the one on Green Road probably have them asphalt.

Powell asked about Grand Rapids Township Trustee Rita Foos Weston Road crossover concerns. Todd stated he has not got in contact with them; they have not been home when he has stopped by. Powell stated Fred Vetter from Middleton Township was looking into tar and chipping Liberty High Road. They were going to contact the Engineer about it. Todd thinks micro chipping may be a better option.

On June 14th there is a Plain Township Chief's Meeting at the Central Joint Fire Hall. Powell stated we had a truck check last night and Bruce Harris is going to start keeping a log on maintenance of the trucks.

Smith asked about the catch basin on Tontogany Creek and replacing it. Todd stated he is waiting on a price from John Topp and Eric Palmer. Smith also asked about the status of the log jams in the ditch. Todd has not got anyone to stop and look at that, he will have Eric look at it when he comes out for the catch basin. Smith wants Patterson's Corner to be taken care of on a regular basis. Smith talked to Schroeder from the insurance company. If Jim's wife wants to volunteer her time to help out the Township we should put her on our payroll so she would be covered by our insurance and workers comp.

Trustees discussed getting someone else to do the trimming to help Todd, so he can get out and do the road mowing. Powell made a motion Euler seconded to hire Hunter Smith as a part-time employee. Roll Call: Powell – yes, Euler – yes, Smith – yes. Motion Approved.

Powell gave the April 2017 Financial Report. Powell wants the Medical Marijuana Resolution that was passed to be put in the Zoning Book and online.

Smith stated the residents on Old Coach Road want to know if they can close this road for a day on June 10th. Todd said he will put road closure signs out.





Andy Moser, he found someone to take over the Rec Council for next year; the new guy is learning the ropes from Andy this year. Euler talked to Laurie Limes about the website; Nichole Wallace will be contacting him on the website. Euler stated Range line has quite a few potholes that need filled. Todd stated we need to make a formal request for the Engineer to make the formal plans. Trustees asked Kristel to create the formal letter for the beginning of the month so they can sign. Todd expressed the County changed the size of pipe that they will work on, it is now 48 inches or bigger. Euler said the workers comp class he was going to attend was cancelled; he will schedule to attend another class. Euler received a call from Tom Euler about mowing the cemeteries and around the head stones. Once we add the extra labor that should help us out. Euler discussed Robinson Road is falling apart roughly 3/10 of a mile. We could get a bid on it and then see when we can do it. Todd stated if we are going to do this it will need widened as well. Powell suggested having Rich Hertzfeld look at Robinson Road when they are doing Range Line Road. Trustees were in agreement to get formal plans for Robinson Road along with Range line.

Because of no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:35 p.m.
