The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer.

The minutes from the January 8, 2018 meeting were read and approved.

Zach Sarver gave a report on Troy Township's Fire and EMS runs in Webster Township during 2017. The largest fire run was the fire at Stickels. Between the three times fire departments responded, over 500,000 gallons of water was used. This is the largest amount of water moved in Wood County since it was first kept track of in 1941. Zach Sarver also discussed some changes Troy Township may be making in the next couple of years such as a new radio system.

Isaac Bailey reported he did get the pictures of the old truck uploaded to www.govdeals.com and will get the listing up and running.

Isaac Bailey also put up the For Sale signs on the property on Devils Hole and Webster Roads.

Randy Aspacher mentioned that the refrigerator in the hall actually does work, so the order from Franks was cancelled.

Julie Foos finished collecting the necessary information to get driving records from the Bureau of Motor Vehicles for the Trustees and Randy Aspacher.

Isaac Bailey mentioned that the demolition of Webster School is under way.

Dave Welling then gave his report on zoning. He has issued three permits so far this year and will do another audit when the weather gets better. Dave Welling said he has been using the form he created for buildings that are used for agricultural purposes and do not need permits. Jim Cajka mentioned a resident has been doing some advertising for a business located in Webster Township. Dave Welling will contact the resident and discuss an in-home permit. The Zoning Commission will meet on February 6 at 7:30 P.M. to reorganize.

Julie Foos gave all the officials their W-2's and discussed their allowances.

Randy Aspacher discussed some issues with the new truck. Isaac Bailey will see if the county garage can handle it. Randy Aspacher asked if there was anywhere he could dump partial loads of stone and salt to mix.


