

GRAND RAPIDS TOWNSHIP REGULAR MEETING

March 26, 2018

The Grand Rapids Township Trustees met at 7:00 A.M. in the Grand Rapids Township Fire Hall. David Chamberlain, Ike Topp and Rita Foos answered roll call. There were six guests present.

Rita Foos moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes, as copies were made available to guests. 2nd by Ike. Roll Call YES: Ike Topp, David Chamberlain and Rita Foos. Motion carried.

Bills in the amount of \$9,014.73 were presented for approval by the Fiscal Officer. Rita Foos moved to pay all bills as presented. 2nd by Ike Topp. Roll Call YES: David Chamberlain, Ike Topp and Rita Foos. Motion carried.

Zoning inspector Tom Hall updated the board on zoning activity in the township.

There was a short discussion on the ditch repair done on Weston Road. It was decided to pay for 10% of the project.

Ike Topp informed the board that he met with the Wood County Engineer to discuss options for correcting the drainage issues on Pratt Lane and that he will draw up plans for contactors to bid from.

Rita Foos informed the board that the township can purchase a numeric lock from BG Lock for \$200 that has the capability for one time use codes.

There was a short discussion on excessive planting and decorating at some of the grave sites in Beaver Creek Cemetery. It was decided to contact the families and inform them of the rules of the cemetery.

Rita Foos said that she encountered someone who was doing a road bore on County Line Road and got them a permit so they could pay the proper fee.

Rita Foos informed the board that we are supposed to get an inch of rain tomorrow and that it would be a good time to drive around the township to look for drainage issues.

David Chamberlain said the he got an estimate from Crozier Body Shop to repair the fender on the truck for \$751.78 and that he took the truck to Ludwig's to get the electrical issue fixed and that it cost \$111.68.

Terry Green informed the board that there is a dead pine tree in the cemetery and requested permission to have Tim Obermyer help him remove it. Ike Topp said that he would like to take a look at it first.
