The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer.

The minutes from the February 12, 2018 meeting were read and approved.

The Trustees began by discussing the county permitting process. The County Engineer will put together a resolution for townships to look over.

Isaac Bailey reported that he has approved the listing for the old truck on [www.govdeals.com](http://www.govdeals.com), but the representative has not made it live yet.

Discussion turned to the health insurance renewal. Julie Foos said that Ohio Insurance Services Agency received the responses from the online questionnaire but they have not received any updated quotes.

Jim Cajka mentioned the recent house fire in the township and how the township is enrolled in a program to put a portion of the settlement into escrow in case the township incurs any charges.

The Township Clean-Up Day was discussed next. The date is tentatively set for April 21 starting at 8:00 A.M. People can come to the township building to pick up supplies and drop off the full bags. Once the date is official, Julie Foos will notify Eastwood Schools and the Girl Scouts.

All the Trustees will try to attend the safety meeting concerning the Nexus pipeline. Julie Foos will try to find a haul route map for the pipeline.

Isaac Bailey reported that the lid for the catch basin on Alexander Road is not done yet.

Mark Bushman moved to let the Board of Elections use the hall for the election on May 8. Isaac Bailey seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Isaac Bailey reported that the Prosecutor's Office should be getting a proposed deed for the Webster School property. Jim Cajka was disappointed that the contractors were not putting enough bricks out for people to take.

The Trustees have gotten lots of complaints about how the Toussaint Creek cleaning has been going, such as debris left in the ditch and the contractors bouncing around from one area to another.

The catch basin on the southeast corner of Sugar Ridge Road and Webster Road caved in, and the County has been notified.

Isaac Bailey discussed changes the health department made effective January 1, 2018. Before anyone can get a zoning permit, they will need to go to the Health Department to have their septic tank inspected. After the Wood County Building Inspector signs off on their system, they will be put on a schedule to have their system looked at every five years. No system will be grandfathered in. Isaac Bailey has contacted the Commissioners to complain about these changes.






