The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the March 12, 2018 meeting were read and approved.

The Trustees approved the Purchase Orders and Blanket Certificates for 2018.

Jim Cajka mentioned that the property on State Route 582 that recently burned will be cleaned up but there is a hold on the process.

The Trustees reviewed the bridge ratings from the County Engineer.

Isaac Bailey reported that he got a new contact person for GovDeals, and the old truck has been listed. The payment process was discussed. The auction ends on March 29.

There was no update on the Webster School property.

Isaac Bailey had gotten another call about the Devils Hole property, but no offers have been made.

Jim Cajka and Mark Bushman attended the Nexus safety meeting and said it mostly covered what would happen in an emergency situation.

Julie Foos will contact Eastwood Schools and the Girl Scouts and inform them of the Township Clean-Up Day on April 21.

The Trustees discussed putting together a committee for the Webster School baseball and soccer fields. There has been some interest in keeping them maintained. The Trustees decided not to do anything until the Township is sure it will own the property. Isaac Bailey will check with Brent Welker to see where the District is in the process.

Mark Bushman moved to approve the proposed Facebook posts as read. Isaac Bailey seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Jim Cajka will talk with someone at Freedom Township and get more information about applying for a road grant.

The Trustees then opened the bids for mowing. Yardwork and Snow Removal, LLC bid \$750 to mow the Webster Cemetery, \$60 to mow the Hall, and \$80 to mow the Old Belleville Ridge Cemetery. Behind the Pines bid \$400 to mow the Webster Cemetery and \$125 to mow the Hall. Sarver and Sons Construction, LLC bid \$550 to mow the Webster Cemetery and \$45 to mow the Hall. Joe Kirkman bid \$125 to mow the Old Belleville Ridge Cemetery. Zach Sarver asked questions about liability insurance, spring clean-up, and the mole hills. Isaac Bailey made a motion to accept the bid from Yardwork and Snow Removal, LLC for \$80 to mow the Old Belleville Ridge Cemetery. Jim Cajka seconded the motion and all were in favor. Mark Bushman made a motion to award the Webster Cemetery to Behind the Pines for \$400. Jim Cajka seconded the motion and all were in favor. Jim Cajka made a motion for Sarver and Sons Construction, LLC to mow the township hall for \$45. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor. Isaac Bailey will contact each bidder and will ask for proof of insurance and a W-9.




