The Grand Rapids Township Trustees met at 7:00 A.M. in the Grand Rapids Township Fire Hall. David Chamberlain, Ike Topp and Rita Foos answered roll call. There was one guest present.

Rita Foos moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes, as copies were made available to guests. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ike Topp. Roll Call YES: Ike Topp, David Chamberlain and Rita Foos. Motion carried.

The Fiscal Officer presented bills in the amount of \$8,893.49 for approval. Rita Foos moved to pay all bills as presented. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ike Topp. Roll Call YES: David Chamberlain, Ike Topp and Rita Foos. Motion carried.

There was a review of the letter the Wood County Prosecutors' office sent to the Lawson's in regards to the building on their property that they did not obtain a variance for.

Bids to remove trees from the cemetery and roadsides were reviewed. The bids came in a lot higher than expected because of the difficulty contactors would have in getting their equipment in the cemetery.

After reviewing the crack sealing bids, Rita Foos moved to hire Premier Patching to crack seal Milton Road between Kellogg and Wintergreen Roads for approximately \$10,750 and GT Contracting to do Wintergreen Road between Weston and Milton Roads for approximately \$7,900. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ike Topp. Roll Call YES: Ike Topp, David Chamberlain and Rita Foos. Motion carried.

Rita Foos mentioned that she has tried to contact Denver Gietgey to see if a zoning meeting had been set up but she has not heard back from him.

Rita Foos informed the board that she would be attending a BWC class in September, the class is necessary so the township can maintain the EM Cap discount for the 2018 policy year.
