

GRAND RAPIDS TOWNSHIP REGULAR MEETING

September 10, 2018

The Grand Rapids Township Trustees met at 7:00 P.M. in the Grand Rapids Township Fire Hall. David Chamberlain, Ike Topp and Rita Foos answered roll call. There were eight guests present.

Rita Foos moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes, as copies were made available to guests. 2nd by Ike Topp. Roll Call YES: Ike Topp, David Chamberlain and Rita Foos. Motion carried.

The Fiscal Officer presented bills in the amount of \$86,698.49 for approval. Rita Foos moved to pay all bills as presented. 2nd by David Chaberlain. Roll Call YES: David Chamberlain, Ike Topp and Rita Foos. Motion carried.

Fire Chief Eric Flora reported 14 runs to the Board and informed them that the new MARCS radios have been installed and are working well.

Rita Foos moved to nominate Steve Arnold to fill the vacant seat on the Northwest Water and Sewer District board. 2nd by David Chaberlain. Roll Call YES: Ike Topp, David Chamberlain, and Rita Foos. Motion carried.

After receiving a letter of resignation from Zoning Commission members Tom Sorosiak, Al Wellman, Ken Knaggs and Denver Geitgey; David Chamberlain moved to accept their resignation. 2nd by Rita Foos. Roll Call YES: David Chamberlain, Ike Topp and Rita Foos. Motion carried. David Chamberlain also thanked them for their years of service.

Leann Lawson spoke and said that she had sent correspondence in July requesting that she be notified before her property is discussed and wanted to know why she was not notified of the last discussion on her property. Fiscal Officer Cary Long stated that the Board had acted on advice from Linda Holmes, the Board had given the Lawson's a time frame to file for an appeal, they did not file for an appeal so the Board addressed the situation. Mrs. Lawson said that since she was not here she was unable to respond to the request that her gate be moved. David Chamberlain asked Mrs. Lawson if she had read the last letter from Linda Holmes; and stated that everything has been discussed and that the Board acted on the recommendation from Linda Holmes. Mrs. Lawson wanted to know how many people have complained about her fence, Rita Foos answered that she has received three complaints about the location of the fence. Ike Topp asked Mrs. Lawson what she would like for a resolution to this situation. Mrs. Lawson said she would need time to come up with an answer.

Rita Foos brought up the resurfacing of the Fire department parking lot, Ike Topp suggested that we do half of the lot this year and half next year. After reviewing the estimate from Morlock Asphalt LTD. Rita Foos moved to resurface the front section of the parking lot for \$1,920.00. 2nd by Ike Topp. Roll Call YES: Ike Topp, David Chamberlain and Rita Foos. Motion carried.

Rita Foos mentioned that she will be attending the Wood County Township Association meeting on Thursday.

Ike Topp informed the Board that he received a complaint about the mowing at the cemetery. Ike Topp said that he has talked with Perry Dela-Hamaide and believes the situation is resolved.
