The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the August 12, 2019 meeting were read and approved.

The Trustees discussed the bill from Toledo Edison. Isaac Bailey will call and question why it is always higher than expected.

The meeting turned to old business. Isaac Bailey spoke with Aurora Biggs with ODOT, and the State does have money allotted to fix parts of Anderson Road and Devils Hole Road. The Trustees all agreed to hold off on fixing the roads until later since it is likely they will continue to be damaged as the State Route 582 project continues. Isaac Bailey will ask the County what sign would be appropriate to warn drivers about the condition of Devils Hole Road west of State Route 199. Jim Cajka also talked to Aurora Biggs about some patch work that needs to be done. Julie Foos reported that for multiple days State Route 582 was completely mud and would have been unpassable with much more rain. Julie Foos mentioned that ODOT has continued to work on the road, and it is now more drivable. Mark Bushman said he spoke with the County and they have not been able to patch any of the potholes yet. Randy Aspacher will see if he can get some cold patch elsewhere. Jim Cajka would like to see the potholes fixed by the Durapatcher if possible. The Trustees, Gary Evers, and Mike Evers discussed fixing Main Road next year after the pipeline project is completed. Gary Evers would like the Trustees to ask the County to fix the bridge abutment on Main Road. Isaac Bailey will talk to the County.

Isaac Bailey reported the Soccer Association has taken care of the trash barrels and the restrooms at the Webster School property. The Soccer Association would like to know when the property has been mowed so they can reline the fields.

Jim Cajka will contact the auctioneer to see if there is anything else the Township needs to do before the sale of the Devils Hole Road property. Isaac Bailey mentioned the property behind the Township's lot and the neighboring residence is also for sale.

Julie Foos has nothing new to report on the audit.

The Trustees reviewed the bids for propane for the coming winter. Isaac Bailey made a motion to accept L.A. Bexten's bid for \$0.92 per gallon. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor. The Trustees and Randy Aspacher talked about how they will need to be more vigilant in checking how much propane is in the tank.

The meeting turned to new business. Isaac Bailey was invited to the Eastwood Community Improvement Corporation's next meeting to discuss plans for the Webster School property. The Trustees agreed that many decisions need to be made about the location of future buildings. Isaac Bailey will see how the ECIC is offering to help.


