

GRAND RAPIDS TOWNSHIP REGULAR MEETING

August 26, 2019

The Grand Rapids Township Trustees met at 7:00 A.M. in the Grand Rapids Township Fire Hall. Ike Topp, David Chamberlain and Rita Foos answered roll call. There were three guests present.

Rita Foos moved to approve and dispense with the reading of the minutes, as copies were available to guests. 2nd by Ike Topp. Roll Call YES: Ike Topp, David Chamberlain and Rita Foos. Motion carried.

The Fiscal Officer presented bills in the amount of \$10,035.87 for approval. Rita Foos moved to pay all bills as presented. 2nd by David Chamberlain. Roll Call YES: David Chamberlain, Ike Topp and Rita Foos. Motion carried.

Zoning Inspector Tom Hall updated the Board on zoning issues in the Township and informed them that he needs to check out the property on the corner of Wapokeneta Road and Route 6 because they are accumulating a lot of stuff on their property. He also reported that there is a building going up on Wintergreen Road that may have setback issues. Rita Foos stated that once the new zoning resolution is passed we need to start knocking on doors or sending letters to residents in violation of the resolution.

George Foos, President of the Zoning Commission attended the meeting to answer questions that the Board may have on the proposed resolution. George Foos informed the Board that the Commission has met every month starting in January and that the Commission had consulted with Dave Steiner of the Wood County Planning Commission. George Foos said most of the changes made had to do with language clarifications, grammar and fees; he also pointed out that there is not a provision for residents to have a junk car on their property. George Foos also said that their next meeting is scheduled for the second Tuesday in January. After a general discussion by the Board, it was decided to hold a public hearing September 9, 2019, at 6:30 P.M in the fire station.

After discussing meeting time options, it was agreed by the Board to hold Trustee meetings on the 2nd a 4th Monday of the month at 7 P.M in the Fire station.

Rita Foos informed the Board that there was a problem with the disc mower and that it will be at the dealer for a couple of days for repair.
