The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the August 26, 2019 meeting were read and approved.

The meeting started with old business. Mark Bushman discussed the work the County did to fix a tile on Silverwood Road. Isaac Bailey reported empty dump trucks are still using Anderson Road as part of the haul route for the State Route 582 project. Mark Bushman would like to see Randy Aspacher patch some potholes on Devils Hole Road and Anderson Road. Mark Bushman replayed a complaint from a resident about a neighbor's brush growing up around a catch basin near a ditch. All of the Trustees have noticed the issue and will get the brush cut back.

Isaac Bailey talked about the Eastwood Community Improvement Corporation's meeting he attended. The group would like to put together a meeting with Freedom, Troy, and Webster Township to discuss the local fire departments and ways to work together.

Isaac Bailey reported the Soccer Association has been having games at the Webster School property and everything has been going well. The Trustees discussed removing the mulch and rubber on the playground and starting over with new mulch in the spring.

The Trustees discussed the sale of the Devils Hole Road property coming up on September 23. The Trustees and Julie Foos have been getting the word out. Julie Foos will contact Joyce Nowak at the Prosector's office to make sure the township is prepared for the sale.

The Trustees talked about various properties around the township that need to be torn down or maintained better. Jim Cajka would like to get serious about doing something with the abandoned houses.

Julie Foos has nothing to report on the audit.

Jim Cajka mentioned that Dave Welling is still working with Joyce Nowak on the request he received for a public utilities exemption.

Mark Bushman asked the Trustees to look at a property with dirt mounds near the property line. Jim Cajka mentioned he does not think there is anything in the Zoning Resolution pertaining to dirt mounds without a pond, but he will talk to Dave Welling about it.

The meeting turned to new business. Julie Foos said the township will be receiving a new printer in October from UAN.

Jim Cajka mentioned he has received some questions about a labor camp in the township. The Trustees discussed if the labor camp should no longer be exempt from zoning if it is being used as a rental rather than for personal farm labor.

Mark Bushman mentioned the township needs to vote on an appointment to the Board of the Northwestern Water and Sewer District by November 1.
