The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the March 9, 2020 meeting were approved as written.

Isaac Bailey made a motion to approve Resolution 20-003, A Resolution Authorizing ACH Payments to Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield for Health Insurance Premiums. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor in a role call vote.

Dave Welling discussed the results of the two recent requests for zoning variances.

Randy Aspacher ordered stone to start berming the roads. Mark Bushman requested Randy Aspacher leave Anderson Road until the end in case the Trustees are able to work something out with ODOT. The Trustees discussed how to proceed with township work during Ohio's Stay-at-Home order due to the coronavirus situation. Isaac Bailey made a motion to continue to do township work during the current situation. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor. Randy Aspacher will work on berming by himself. Randy Aspacher left the meeting.

Isaac Bailey notified everyone the County garage is closed for the time being.

Dave Welling requested to put any zoning business that requires him to meet with people on hold until the Stay-at-Home order is lifted. Isaac Bailey made a motion to accept Dave Welling's request. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Isaac Bailey made a motion to cancel Township Clean-Up Day on April 18 until further notice. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Isaac Bailey made a motion to award Chase Greulich the Old Belleville Cemetery mowing for 2020. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Isaac Bailey moved to table all other old business until the next meeting. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor.

The meeting turned to new business. Isaac Bailey made a motion to close the township hall to rentals until further notice. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor. Julie Foos will contact anyone affected.

The Pemberville Library would like to use the Webster Township Cemetery for their historic walk program in either 2020 or 2021. Isaac Bailey made a motion to allow the library to utilize the cemetery for 2020 or 2021. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor. Isaac Bailey reported the sign for the cemetery was repainted.

Mark Bushman presented a quote a resident got from Morlock Asphalt for improving the stone section of Anderson Road. The Trustees agreed to table the decision. Isaac Bailey would like to get a quote from the County as well.

Julie Foos mentioned the township could hold its next meeting remotely if needed as long as the public can also join in. Everyone agreed to wait and see what happens with the coronavirus situation before determining the next meeting's format.
