The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the October 12, 2020 meeting were read and approved.

Jonathan Main Plumbing Heating & Cooling did some work to the heating system in the township hall, and Mark Bushman will call him back out to work out the bugs.

Jim Cajka reported builder Phil Williams thinks the price of building a storage building for the Webster School property has increased greatly recently due to supply issues. Mark Bushman will get in touch with Morton Buildings, Inc. and Worch Lumber.

Isaac Bailey mentioned the trunk or treat and car and tractor show put on by Velocity had a good turnout.

Julie Foos has not gotten an answer from Joyce Nowak regarding the township's ability to accept donations.

Mark Bushman and Jim Cajka asked the County fix some potholes with the Durapatcher. The County is progressing on the bridge replacement on Anderson Road.

Isaac Bailey will finish spraying the roadsides for this year soon and will coordinate any additional spraying with Commercial Mowing, LLC.

Jim Cajka will give all the owners of abandoned houses another warning to get them torn down. The township will start taking action after the first of the year.

The Trustees decided to wait to stencil the cemetery drive until next spring due to the colder temperatures. The Trustees and Julie Foos discussed a kiosk at the cemetery. Mark Bushman will see if he can find an Eagle Scout interested in the project.

Julie Foos gave an update on the Wreaths Across America event on December 19.

There was nothing new to report on the drainage issues, the replacement for the Zoning Commission, or ODOT reimbursement for berming expenses.

Randy Aspacher found 11 tires illegally dumped on Caris Road and took them and the tires from Webster Road to Shrader Tire & Oil. The Trustees will see if there are any programs through the EPA for disposing of tires.

Isaac Bailey shared a quote from Yankee Doodle Flags & More for three new flag poles. The Trustees agreed to buy a new flag pole for the Webster School property and try to repair the flag poles at Webster Township Cemetery and the Township Hall.

The Trustees and Julie Foos discussed the new 911 address signs the township paid for.

The Trustees approved a Facebook post.


