The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the October 26, 2020 meeting were read and approved. The Fiscal Officer's report was also approved.

Mark Bushman poured all the requested gravestone foundations in September, and he might have enough new requests for another round this fall. Mark Bushman's policy is to pour foundations once in the spring and fall unless there are enough requests to warrant an additional full load of concrete.

Mark Bushman called Miller Insurance about the dumped tires but has not heard back.

The Trustees met with Lee Frey with Morton Buildings, Inc. and talked about some of the details of the storage building. Julie Foos printed the contract and final estimate Morton Buildings, Inc. sent, which the Trustees reviewed. Mark Bushman mentioned the township is responsible for preparing the site. With an April build date, the final estimate increased to \$48,536. The Trustees agreed that the materials for the building are still under \$40,000, so the township is still not required to put the building out for bid. Isaac Bailey is going to check into permits needed. Jim Cajka made a motion to go with Morton Buildings, Inc.'s 42'x56'x16' building. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor. Mark Bushman will contact Lee Frey and figure out the next step.

Mark Bushman reported the County removed the catch basin on Silverwood Road. The County also dug out the washout on the corner of Silverwood Road and State Route 105 and filled it with stone and LSM. There are so many utilities going through the area that doing any more work to the corner will get very involved. The Trustees will revisit the issue next summer. Isaac Bailey said the County is going to work on the drainage issue on Dunipace Road. The Trustees discussed the catch basin on Dunipace Road. The County has not fixed all the potholes with the Durapatcher yet.

There was nothing to report on the donation issue, the roadside spray program, abandoned houses, the kiosk for the cemetery, or the replacement for the Zoning Commission.

Julie Foos mentioned the Eastwood Community Wreaths Across America group is getting closer to meeting their goal for sponsored wreaths. Mark Bushman made a motion to sponsor two wreaths. Isaac Bailey seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Julie Foos has been walking through Webster Township Cemetery to check the accuracy of the database so far and will continue to work on the project.

Isaac Bailey reported Jason Sisco with the County talked to ODOT about reimbursing the township for berming expenses. ODOT is maintaining the position that they will not pay for any damages for roads not on their haul route, even if the roads were used without the township's permission. At the time of the State Route 582 project, the township repeatedly asked ODOT to stick to the agreed upon haul route which did not include Anderson Road. Trucks continued to use Anderson Road causing damage, for which ODOT will not reimburse the township.

Isaac Bailey mentioned American Legion Post 240 donated around 40 folding chairs and a large coffee maker to the township for use in the hall.

Jonathan Main Plumbing Heating & Cooling fixed the heating issue in the township hall which was caused by grass in a vent.

The Trustees will meet with DTE Energy on Friday, November 13 to learn about a potential pipeline going through the area.




